Educational requirements and credits.

(A) Definitions

- ~~(1) "Professional degree" means an architectural degree in a program which has been accredited by the "National Architectural Accrediting Board" or a program that retained its accreditation without revocation to a time twenty-four months or less before the applicant graduated or by the Canadian architectural certification board not later than two years after the degree has been awarded.~~
- ~~(2) "NCARB" the "National Council of Architectural Registration Boards."~~
- ~~(3) "EESA" educational evaluation services for architects, a service furnished by a private organization not affiliated with NCARB or any of its member boards.~~

(B) Educational requirements

- ~~(1) All candidates for registration by examination shall:
 - ~~(a) Hold a professional degree in architecture; or~~
 - ~~(b) Obtain an EESA-NCARB evaluation report stating that the applicant has met the NCARB education requirement.~~~~
