3. REPORTS

- a. **Executive Director-** Written report attached. Director Kobe also noted that two bills affecting the medical licensing boards have been introduced, SB 366 and HB 617. The reorganization of the boards does not affect us; however, a proposal to require that all potentially adverse decisions be reviewed by DAS would affect all boards. This review is a direct result of North Carolina State Board Of Dental Examiners v. Federal Trade Commission, No. 13-534
- b. **AIA Ohio-** No report.
- c. **NCARB/Region 4-** Ms. Green reported that she recently attended her second of three FY17 ARE 5.0 Construction and Evaluation committee meetings. Serving on an exam committee is a challenging experience and significant time commitment (rewarded with 12 HSW CEUs per meeting). Board members are encouraged to participate as a way to stay relevant with the examination requirements and the path to licensure.

4. NEW BUSINESS-

- a. **Approval of Out of State Travel-** Mr. Steidl, Ms. Kobe and Mr. Rademacher will travel to Miami Florida December 8-11 to attend the CNARB Committee Summit. This is funded by NCARB. On motion by Mr. Meyers, second by Ms. Green, the Board voted to approve the above out of state travel. Motion passed by a 4-0 vote.
- b. **Board vacancy-**The board briefly discussed how to have someone appointed to the vacancy on the board. Given the uncertain environment, no strong solutions were identified.
- c. **Freedom by Design-**Mr. Meyers will serve as the Board's liaison to the project. He will serve as the advisor to Ohio State's AIAS Chapter. The students will design and build a community service project, which will be funded in part by NCARB.
- d. **FARB Model Board Member Code of Conduct-**No action was taken, in part because it is a duplication of existing board policy and Ohio's Ethics laws prevail in any case.

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5. OLD BUSINESS-

- a. **Board of Building Standards-** Mr. Rademacher reported that Mr. Collins was pleased with the outcome of the meeting. He plans to follow up with Mr. Collins to see if NCARB has provided the requested information on how local building departments could hire interns.

The minutes of the September 30 Special Meeting with the Board of Building Standards were approved. On a motion by Mr. Meyers, second by Ms. Green, the board voted to accept the minutes. Motion passed by a 4-0 vote.

6. **Statute Review-** The Board continued its year-long review of Revised Code Chapter 4703 statutes:
